



# Learning Indicators: Understanding What They Mean

## **MASTERING**

**Self Directed – Student takes ownership of the learning process and is intrinsically motivated to not only succeed, but to acquire a deeper understanding of the situation or concept. Student is reflective and is able to apply acquired knowledge to new situations.**

## **ADVANCING**

**With Prompts – Student is reflective, invested in learning and begins to work independently.**

## **PROGRESSING**

**With Support – Teacher role is changing from “director” to “facilitator” of the learning and is responsible for creating pathways that foster independence.**

## **EMERGING**

**With Guidance – Teacher provides student with clear targets and models a path for success. Student uses the teacher as the primary resource in their pursuit of success.**

## **BEGINNING**

**With Direction – Learning occurs with “step by step” direct instruction and monitoring**

## **LIMITED**

**Extensive support required- Student is not yet able to apply the learning to simple tasks with ‘step by step’ direct instruction and monitoring.**
