Add photos or drawings and details with the audio function and writing tool.</i> ➤ Varies beginning of sentences ➤ Uses transitional words (and, to, then, like, again, as well as, etc.) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Write a recipe and include the steps with transitional words.</i> • <i>Write an instructional guide and include step-by-step instructions to teach a friend or a family member how to accomplish something.</i> ➤ Uses precise language or phrases that are more exact in meaning ➤ Uses multi-syllable word ➤ Uses details, strong verbs, interesting language and dialogue <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Write a rap, song or create a play and perform for your family or friends.</i> ➤ Begins to use paragraphs to organize ideas <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Send an email to a family member</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Uses end punctuation and capital letters correctly ➤ Uses commas and apostrophes correctly with guidance ➤ Edits draft copy for missing punctuation and capitalization <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Ask a friend or family member to read through your work and offer feedback.</i> ➤ Uses standard spelling of frequently used words ➤ Edits draft copy for errors ➤ Uses resources such as personal dictionary, class dictionary and thesaurus <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Complete a writing activity with the app Typo (\$4.99) It has a word prediction function, which will help you identify and write your words accurately.</i> • <i>Download the app My Spelling Test (Free) to practice spelling the words found in your personal dictionary accurately.</i>
