

School bus contractors in Rocky View School Division, and across the province, are currently experiencing driver shortages and a high rate of driver absenteeism due to circumstances beyond their control, which affects reliable bus service. This situation fluctuates daily, so please be sure to monitor the Bus Status App which will provide information regarding late bus routes.

Contractors are working hard to keep all bus routes running while managing the changing scenarios. We are aware that route delays and inconsistent schedules are frustrating for parents and students alike. Several bus drivers are having to run second routes with significant delays just to ensure that students get to school at all. 











